Preparation:

- 2. Write a number on each block from 1 12.



Game Rules:

- 2. Place the blocks in the center of the table along with the questions.
- 3. A team member will pick up a block.
- 4. The team member will answer the question from the handout based on the number on the block.
- 5. The team member will place the block in the center to build the tower.
- 6. Repeat with each team member.

- 2. At the end of the game, the team leader will share the answers with group
- 3. The team leader will share with the entire group.
