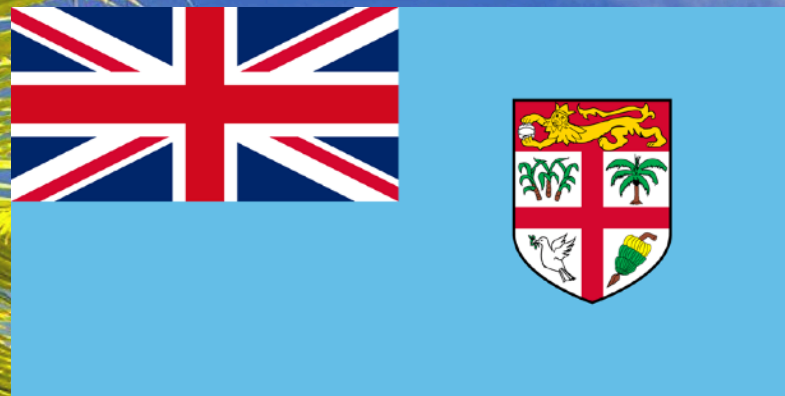


Passport to **FIJI**
